#### **MISCELLANEOUS**

### Pitcher hitting / Pinch hitting

Pitchers sacrifice, even with two strikes.

#### Base running

Run all the A's with aggressiveness (65% or better).

Score at 60%, or 50% with two outs.

Send trailers to second aggressively, to third conservatively

Send low percentage trailer when a runner is also coming home and the chances of him scoring are marginal without help (between 50-70%) and the game beyond the 5<sup>th</sup> inning and it's close (between ahead by 5 runs and down 2 runs). If the chances of him scoring are greater than 70% then don't create an additional out by sending a low percentage trailer. The only exception is if the pitcher is coming up and you are not going to PH for him. In that case, try to create a run prior to his at-bat by sending the trailer!

#### **Throwing**

Outfield throws/cutoffs: Generally be conservative early in the game and more aggressive late in the game.

Always get the sure out on Defense Option plays, unless (1) the chances of the leading runner being safe are less than 35%, or (b) its past the  $7^{th}$  inning and it allows the leading or winning run to score.

Ohtani (166)	He's in the game for at least 7 innings even in dots. He should pitch the $8^{th}$ and $9^{th}$ if not in dots.
Gray (120)	Gray comes out in dots and has a 7-inning max when not in dots.
Mikolas and Cobb	These starters come out in dots. I only really trust Ohtani and he can complete games. If we have a lead then Mikolas, Gray, and Cobb pitch until the 8 <sup>th</sup> where they hand the ball to the closer.
Morton	Out in dots. Try to get 4-5 innings out of him and then he comes out. Keller early and Ottavino late are R vs. R pitchers who are good picks to pitch a couple of innings after Morton.

- The idea is that starters pitch until dots or they reach an innings limit.
- Almonte/Overton are the stoppers to get out of a problematic inning at any time in the game. They will most likely come in with runners on base in high leverage situations. I expect them to finish that one inning and then come out. You can use them both in the same close game to bail us out of jams.
- Keller comes in after the stoppers get us out of a jam before the 6<sup>th</sup>. He has 3 relief innings, so he can pitch a while if we're winning or losing big.
- Martin and Ottavino are the mid-game innings eaters to get to Pressly.
- Pressley is the closer. Overton is the closer if Pressley is not available.


